FOSFA APPOINTMENTS

At its Annual General Meeting, held on 31 October 2018, the Council of FOSFA International (Federation of Oils, Seeds and Fats Associations Ltd) made the following appointments for 2018/19 –

***Mr Remond van Dorland as President, and
Mr Daan Vriens as Deputy President***

Remond van Dorland started his career in vegetable oil trading in 1991 and joined Wilmar Europe Holdings in 2005. In 2012, Wilmar and ADM formed Olenex, a Joint Venture for the production and marketing of vegetable oils and fats in Europe, and in 2018 he was appointed General Manager for all Olenex activities.

Wilmar Europe is a subsidiary of Singapore-headquartered Wilmar International Limited (Wilmar). Founded in 1991, Wilmar is today Asia's leading agribusiness group and is ranked amongst the largest listed companies by market capitalisation on the Singapore Exchange. Wilmar's business activities include oil palm cultivation, oilseed crushing, edible oils refining, sugar milling and refining, manufacturing of consumer products, specialty fats, oleochemicals, biodiesel and fertilisers as well as flour and rice milling. With over 500 manufacturing plants and an extensive distribution network covering China, India, Indonesia and some 50 other countries, Wilmar employs a multinational workforce of about 92,000 people. Wilmar is a firm advocate of sustainable growth and is committed to its role as a responsible corporate citizen.

Daan Vriens started his career as a tropical oils trader in 1997 at Cargill Vegetable Oils after finishing his Business Economics study at the Erasmus University. In this role he has worked in Singapore, Belgium and The Netherlands in the areas of trading, sales, product line and general management. Before leaving Cargill, he was commercially responsible for 23 refineries and bottling units across Europe and gained extensive experience in oils and oilseeds. Daan joined Cefetra in 2012 as CCO and became CEO of Cefetra/BayWa Agri Supply in March 2013.

Cefetra was founded in 1989 with a cooperative background and became part of BayWa in 2012. The independent company is customer focused and functions as a supply chain manager of raw materials to the feed, food and fuel industries. Being supportive by nature, the company trades over 25 million tons of agricultural commodities, provided by 500 employees in 20 offices divided over 12 countries worldwide. As a result, BayWa Agri Supply & Trade is leading in Europe in the agricultural commodities business.
